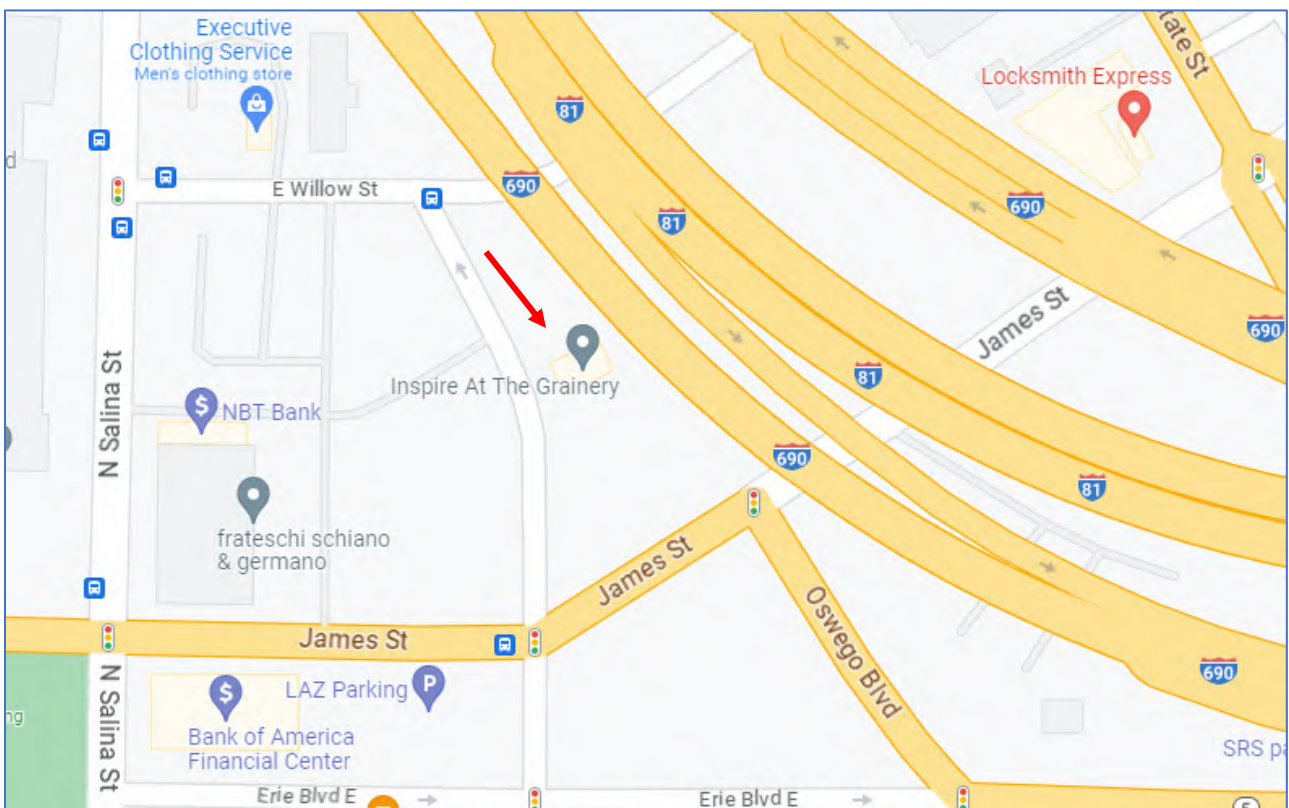

The night woman is more introverted and a different approach to her building of the body- with her nature elements being more with her body structure

The day woman is more extraverted with florals blooming outwardly and birds flying around her and in motion

Visually together these women offer a place of escape in the middle of a concrete jungle downtown with their nature elements. I intentionally picked a water in the right girl since we have so many cool waters and places to hike in the surrounding area.

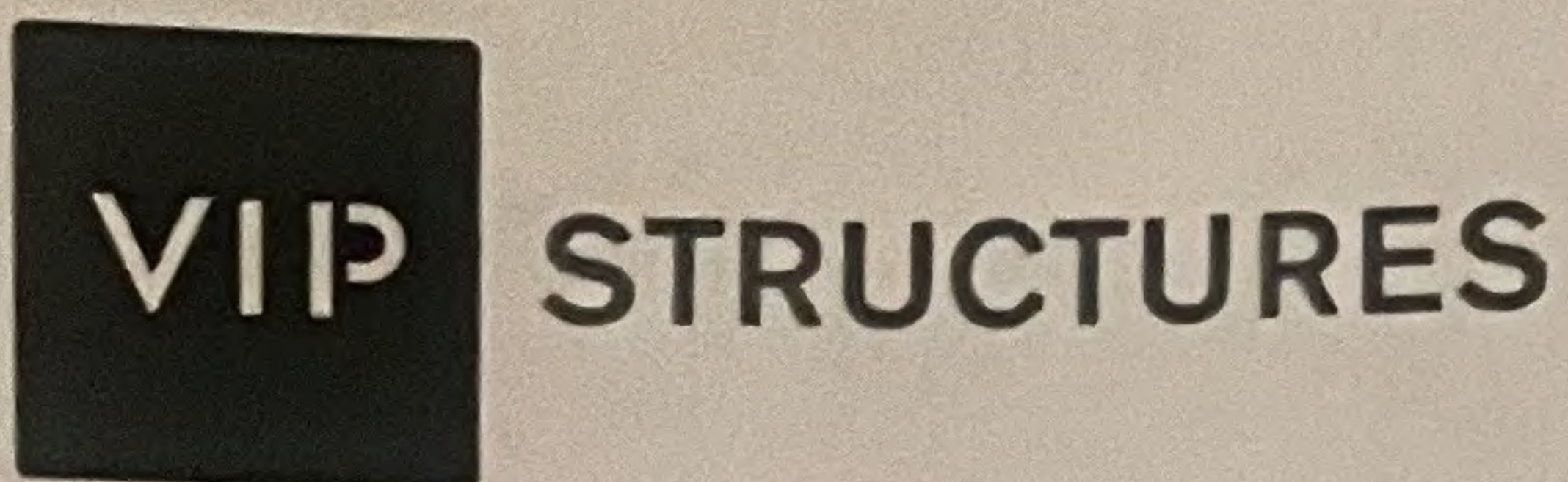
