

Valley in Bloom at 4702 S. Salina Street is the seventh mural in the *City As Canvas* mural program. It was selected by residents of the Valley neighborhood through ranked-choice voting in May 2024.

Intent:


The mural aims to capture the natural beauty of The Valley, celebrating its scenic landscapes and vibrant spirit. Through a birds-eye view, the mural includes Webster Pond surrounded by trees and the historical Stone House on Seneca Turnpike. The skyline of Syracuse stands tall in the distance, symbolizing the city's resilience and progress in relation to The Valley. Through this visual ode, the mural invokes a sense of civic pride, inviting viewers to cherish the harmony between nature and urban life that defines Syracuse.

Timeline:

Begin in early June. Finish by August.

Maintenance:

Using the highest quality materials, there will be no maintenance for at least five years as per the specs of the polycrylic sealant. After the five year period a new coat may be applied to extend the vibrancy of the mural
