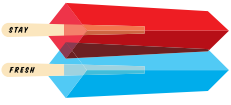

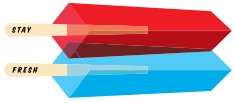

Any remaining funds/supplies available will be set aside of upkeep up to 1 year. We will be getting some paint donated from Stay Fresh and the Art Store.

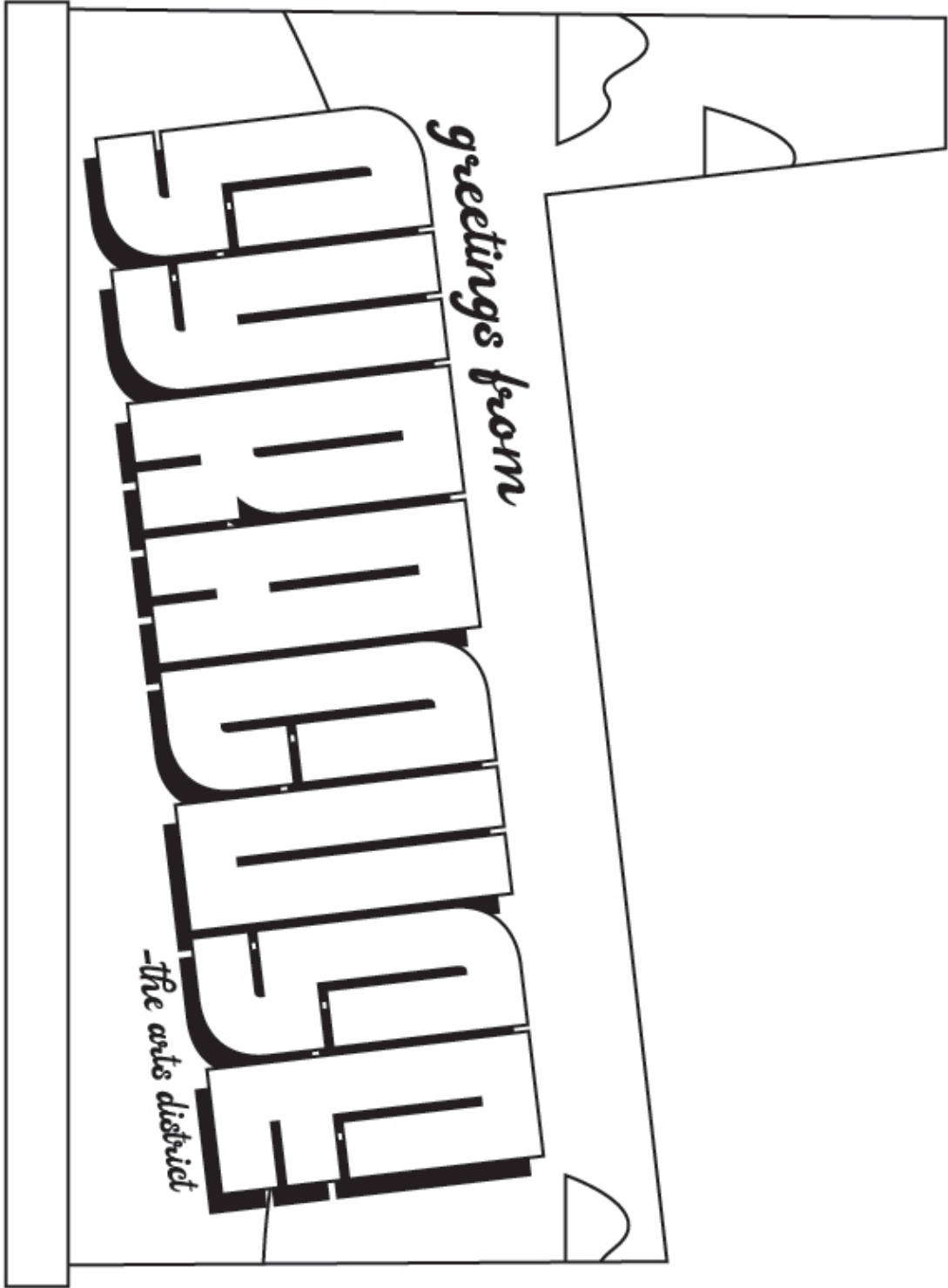
The mural will be created during arts week in July of 2024. Artist and paint demos will also take place during this time.

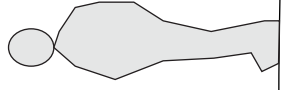
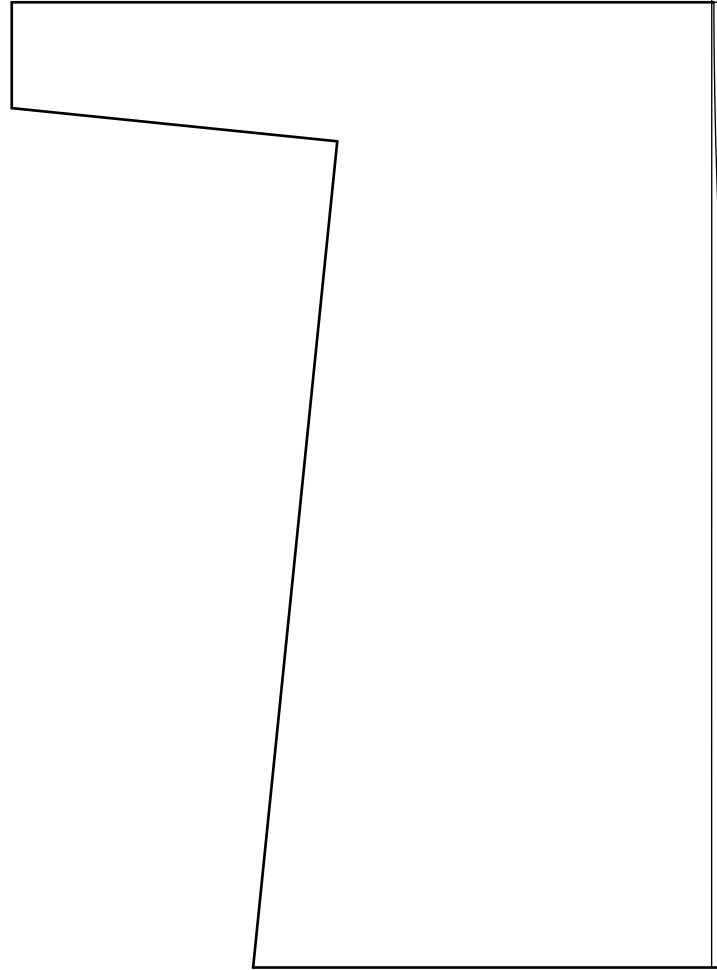
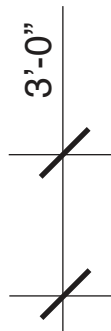
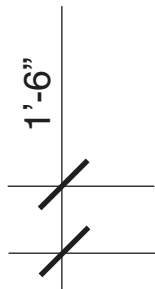


Lipe Art Park 'Shark Wall' -West Facing Wall
