What is COMPSTAT?

COMPSTAT stands for Comparative Statistics. In a weekly meeting of police command staff, divisional supervisors and other personnel, all parties discuss recent Part I criminal activity and proposed strategies to address the situation.

Each meeting covers a three week period, and rotates between the three patrol divisions North, Southwest, Southeast. All three Divisions provide maps, tracking activity in seven different crime types, but only one division presents per week.

Other divisions also report - Criminal Investigations Division, Crime Reduction Team, Special Investigations, Gang Violence Task Force. Those divisions reports are not included in this report because they may contain sensitive law enforcement information.

Glossary and Notes

Part I Crime- The FBI standard for its *Crime in the United States* report, issued each fall. Part I violent crimes are murder or non-negligent homicide, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. Part I property crimes are burglary, larceny, and auto theft.

Red text indicates data increase. **Blue text** indicates data decrease.
Data highlighted red represents the highest total within that offense category.

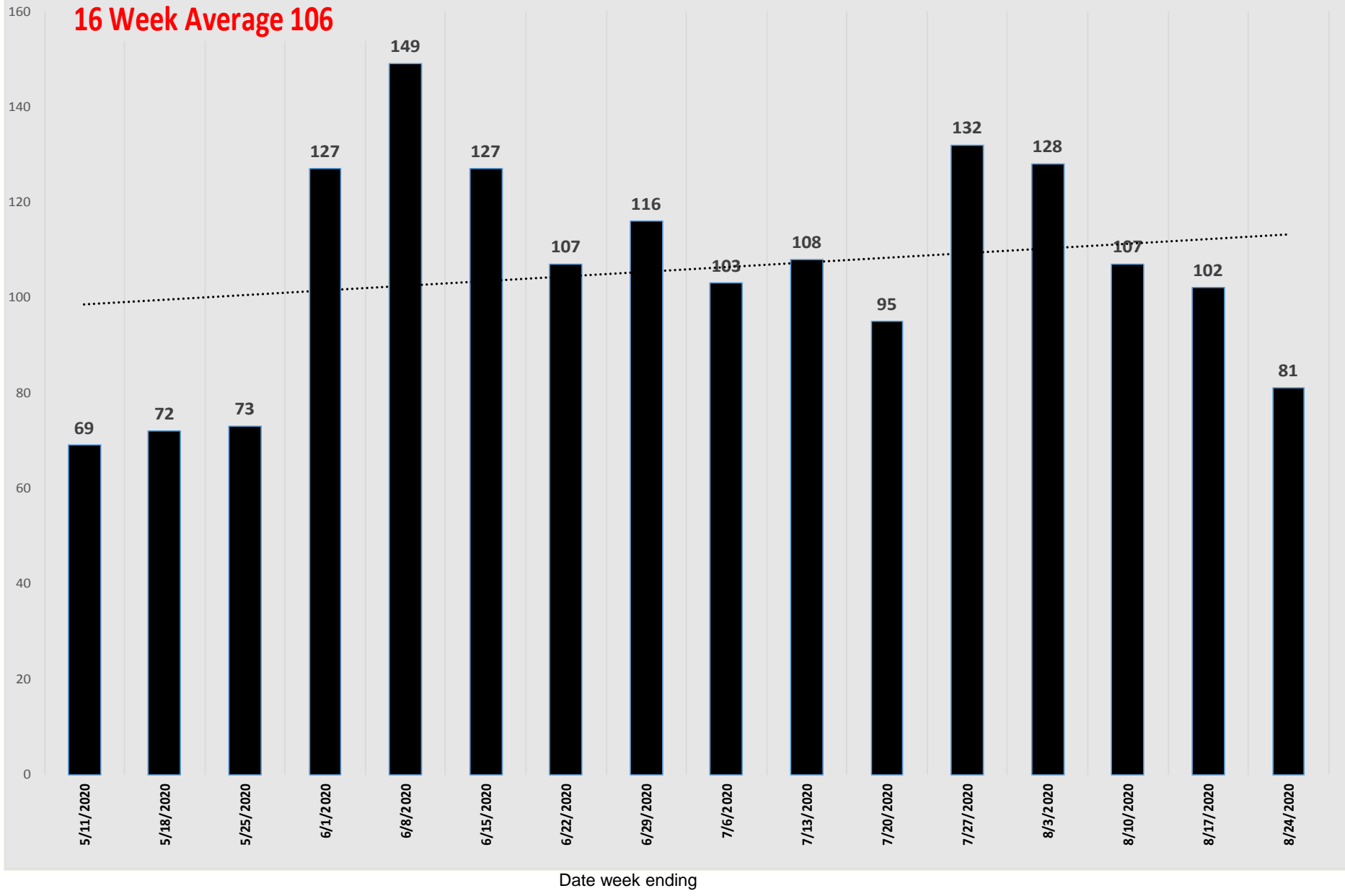

-The Part I offense figures are based on offenses reported to SPD and are retrieved from the department's Records Management System. The figures may include some offenses that may be reclassified after further investigation.

-Calls for service figures are filtered to reflect only dispatched calls. Every effort was made to exclude those calls that were cancelled or withdrawn prior to being dispatched. A percentage of calls cannot be accurately assigned to an SPD district due to 'un-mappable' addresses, i.e. highways. Additionally, 2015 and 2016 address data contain a slightly higher percentage of 'un-mappable' addresses.

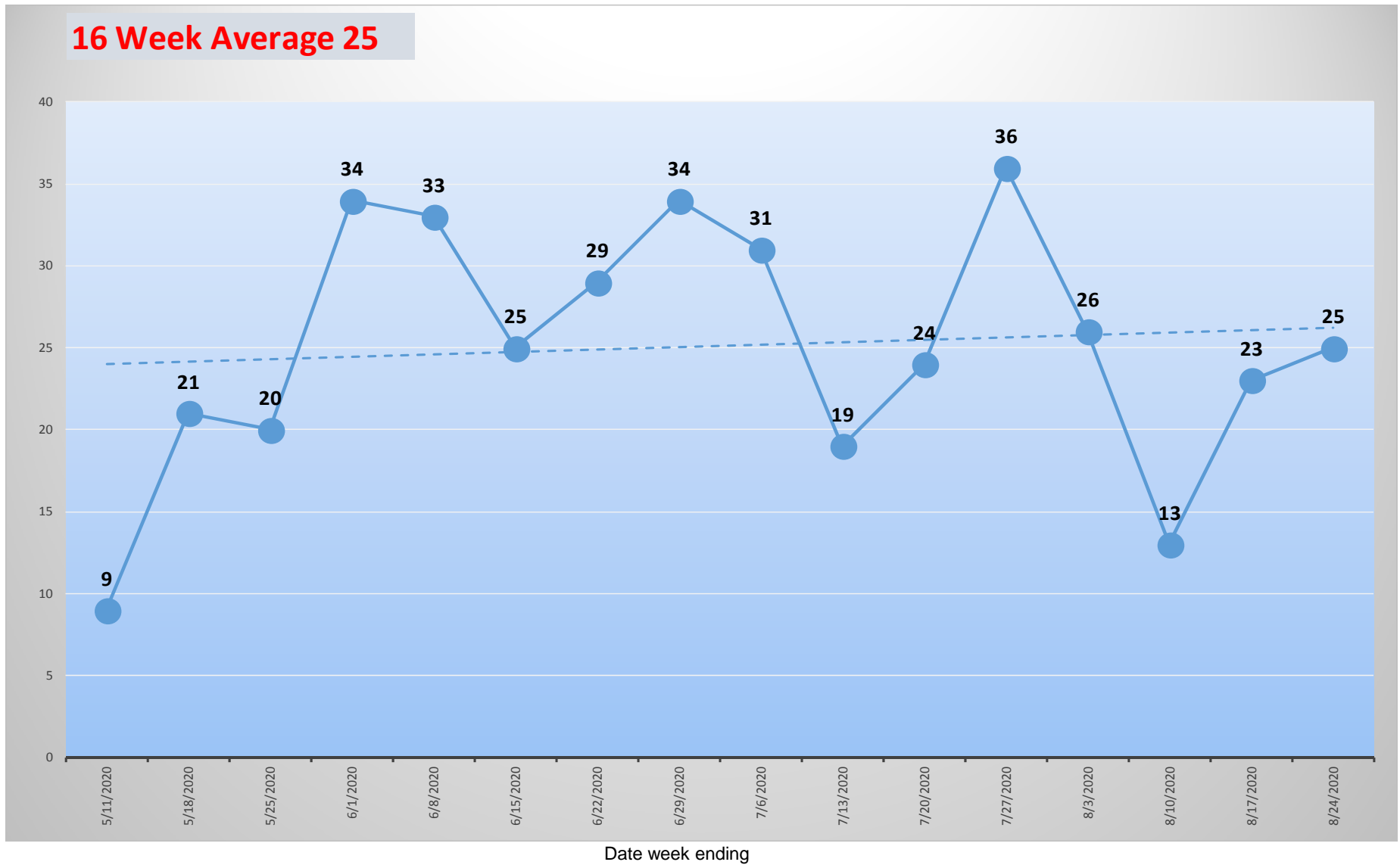
City Wide Total Part I Offenses - Previous 16 Weeks

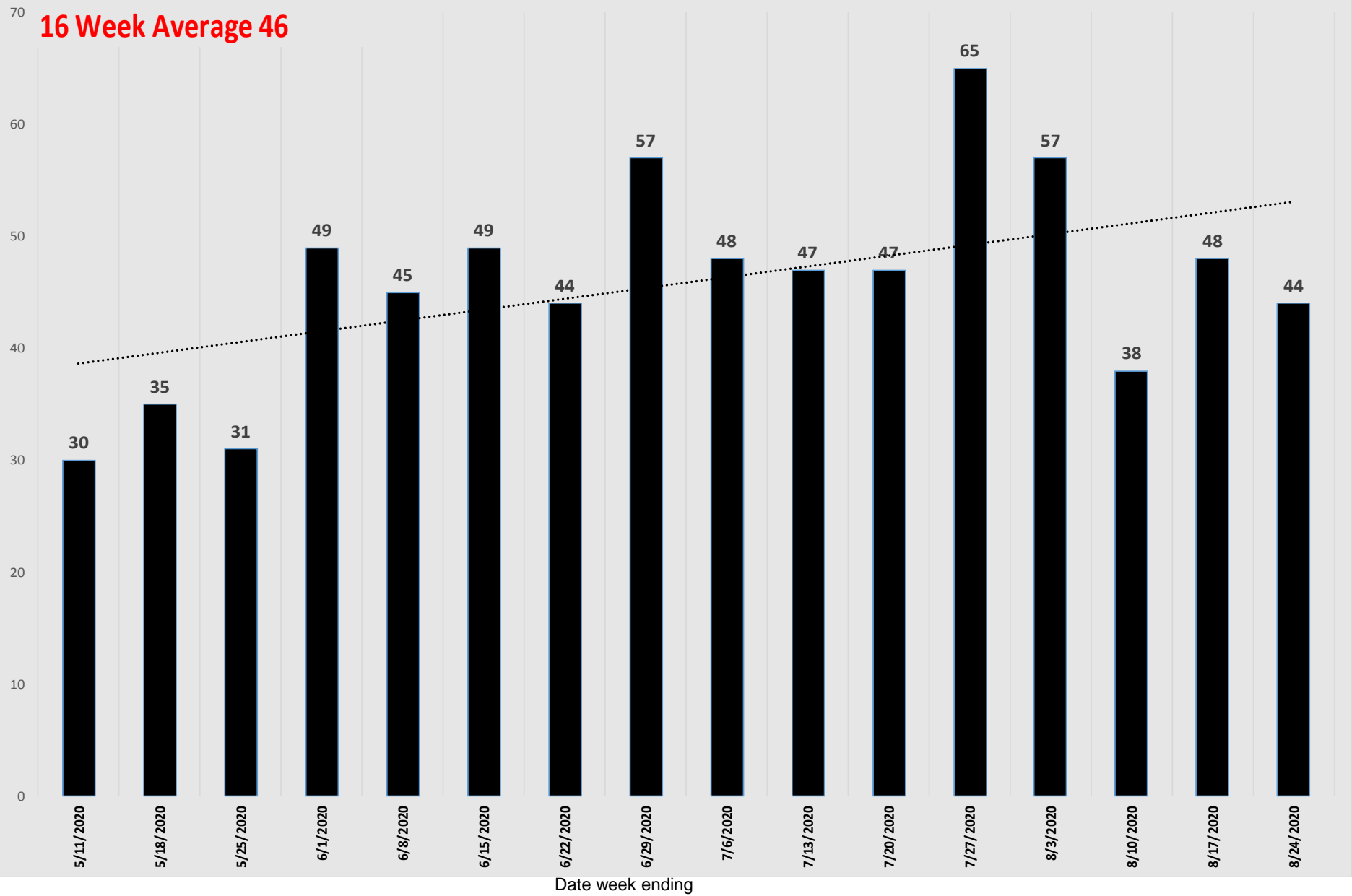

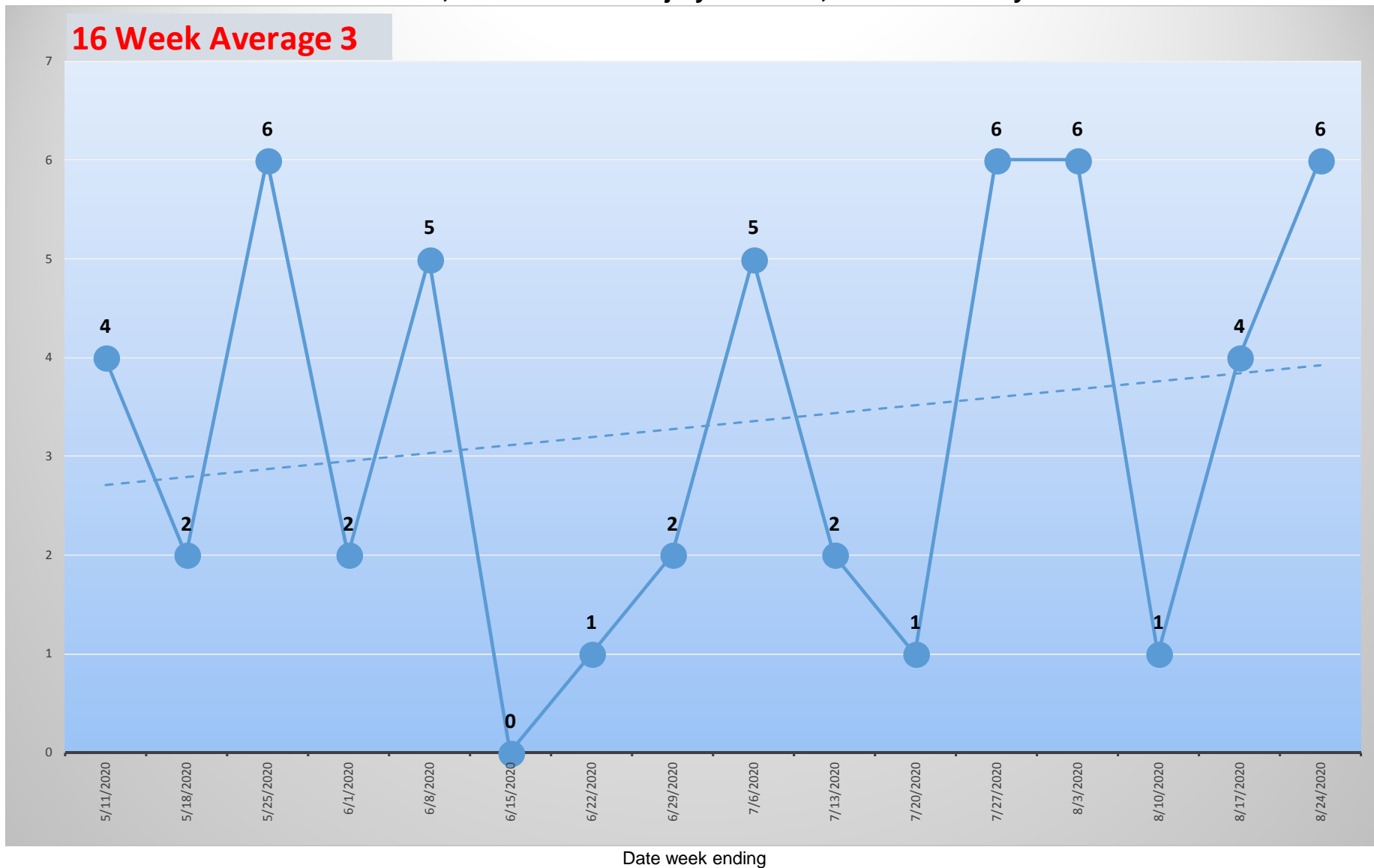
North District Total Part I Offenses - Previous 16 Weeks

North District Previous 16 Weeks – Shots Fired Incidents*

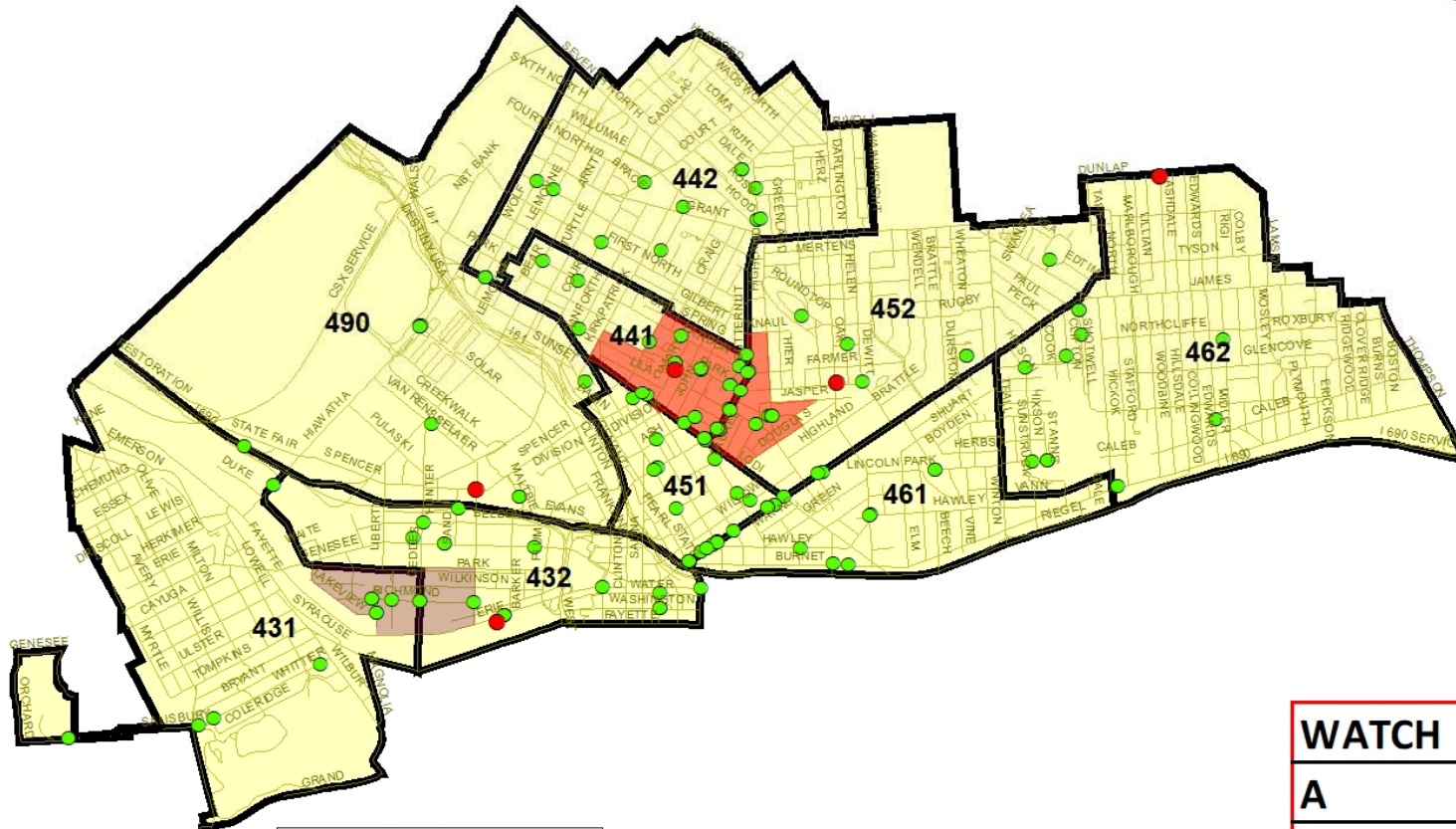

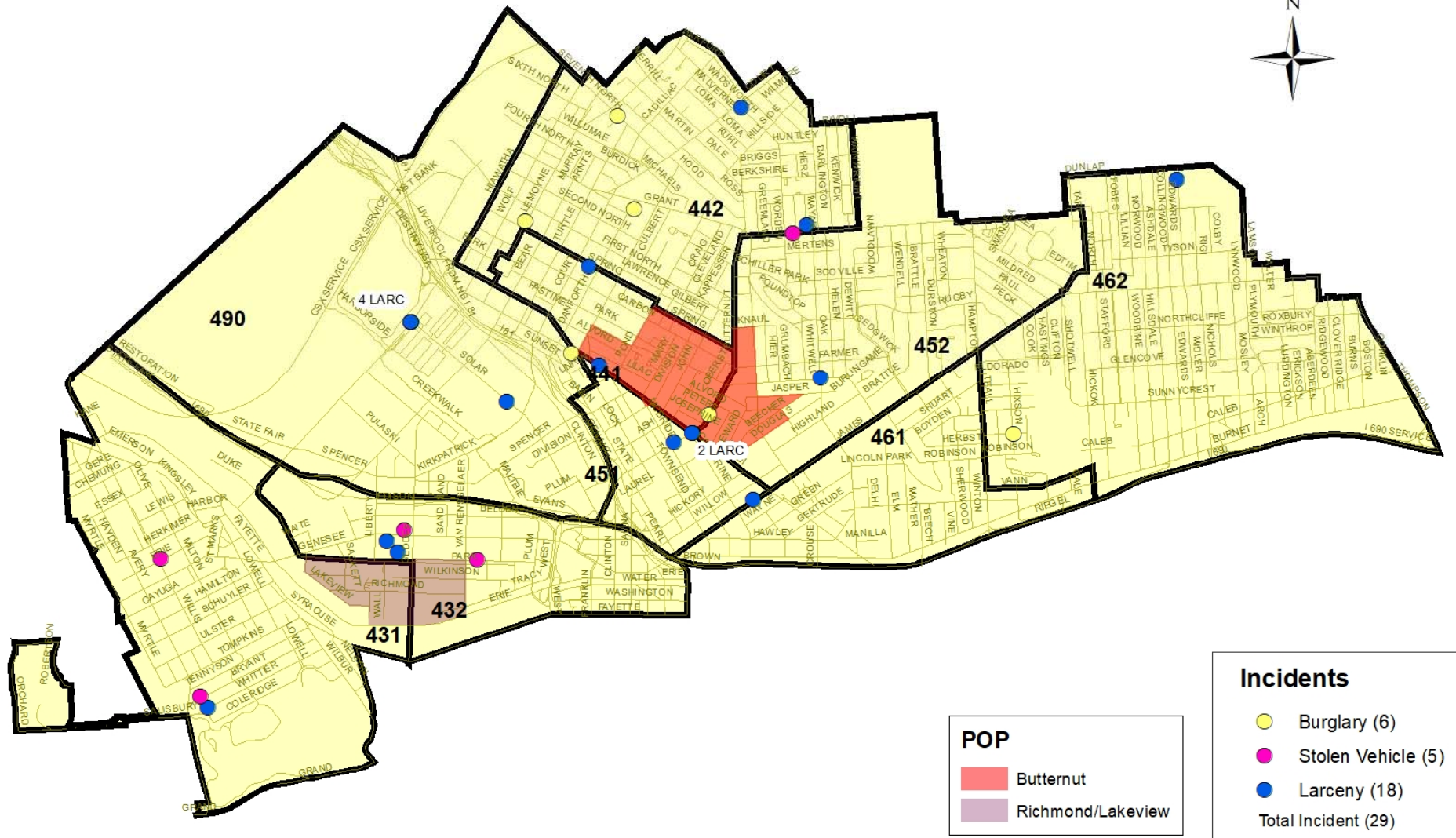

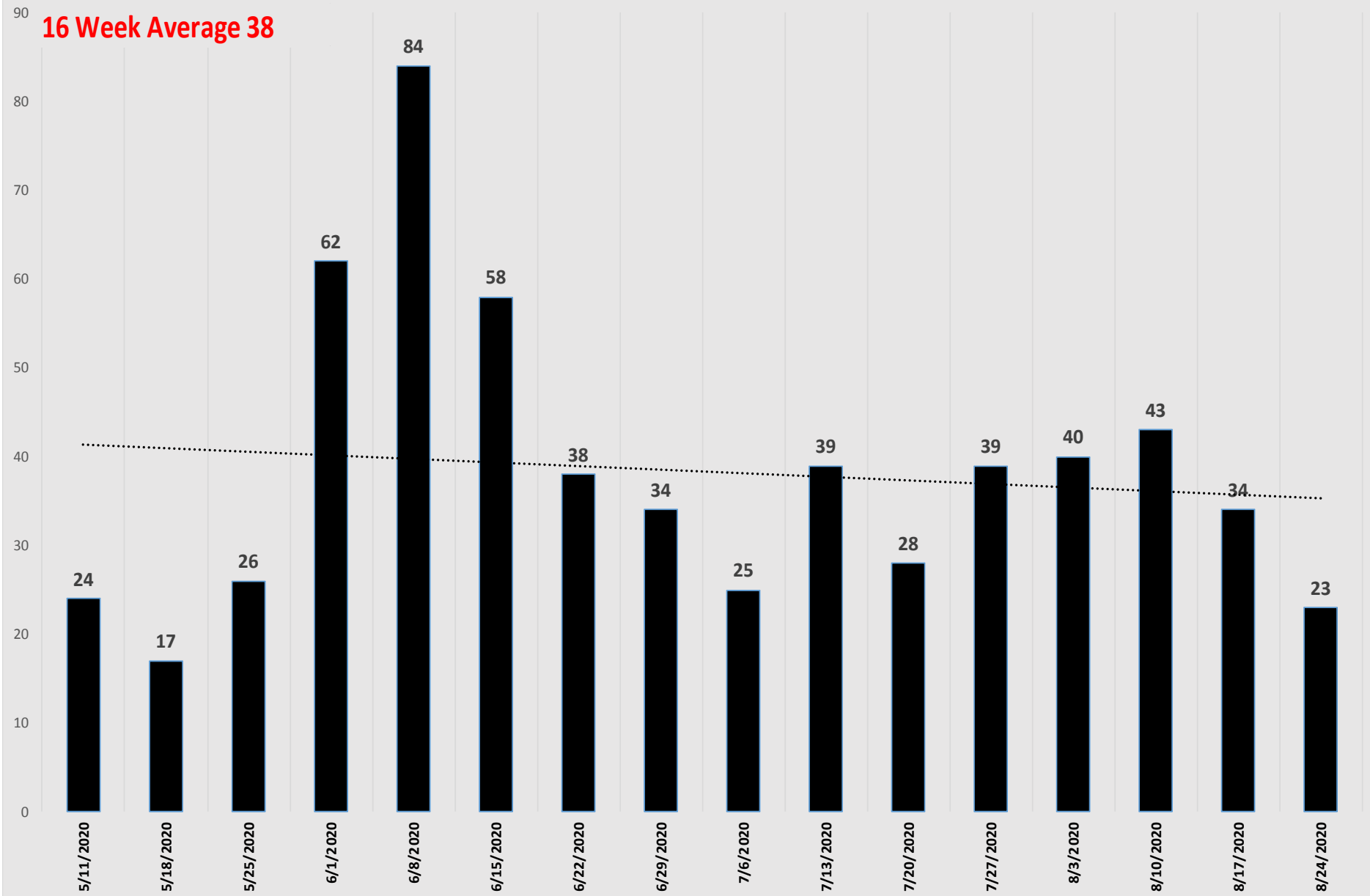

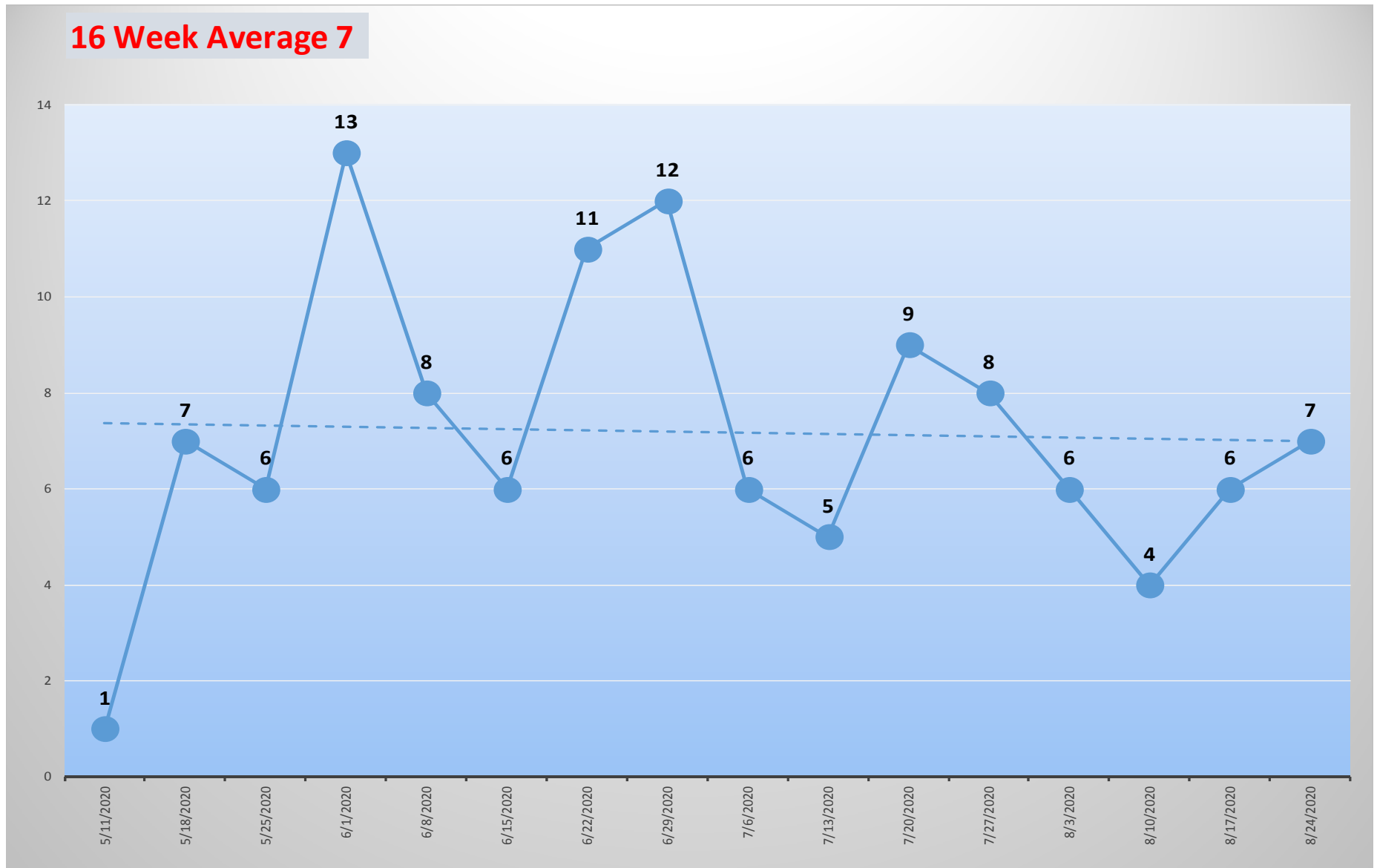
SE District Total Part Offenses - Previous 16 Weeks

Southeast District Previous 16 Weeks – Shots Fired Incidents*

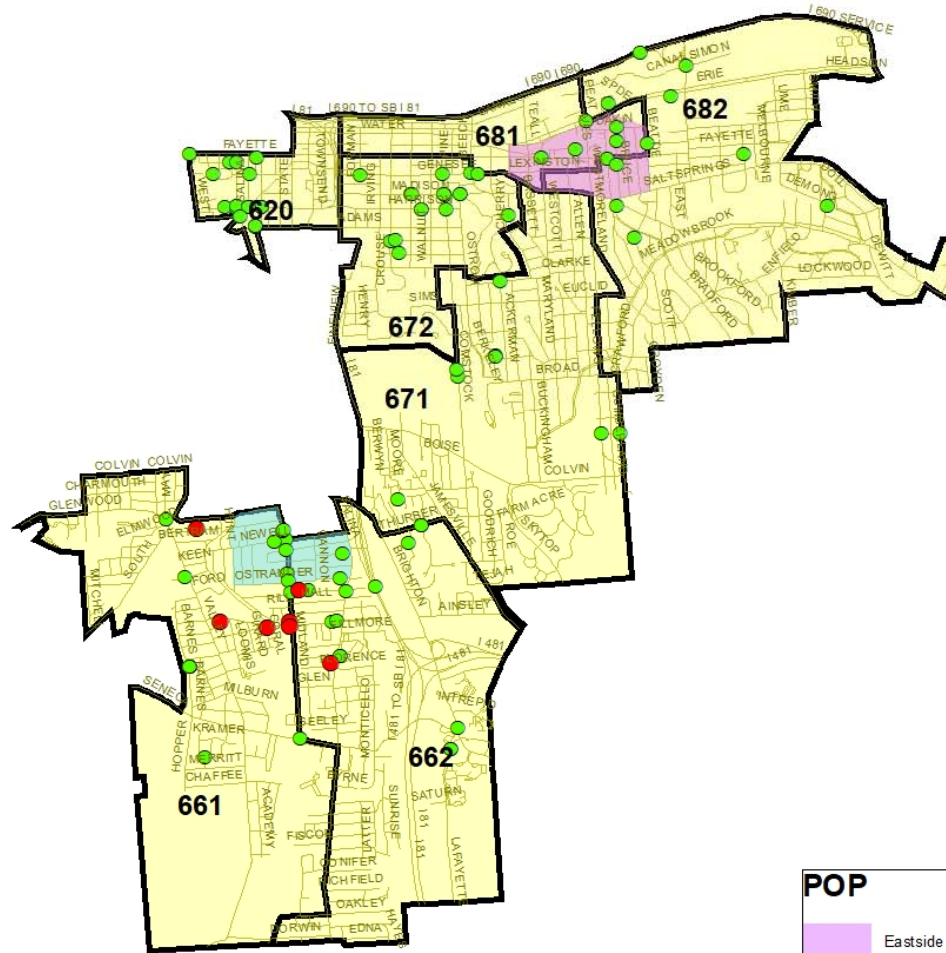

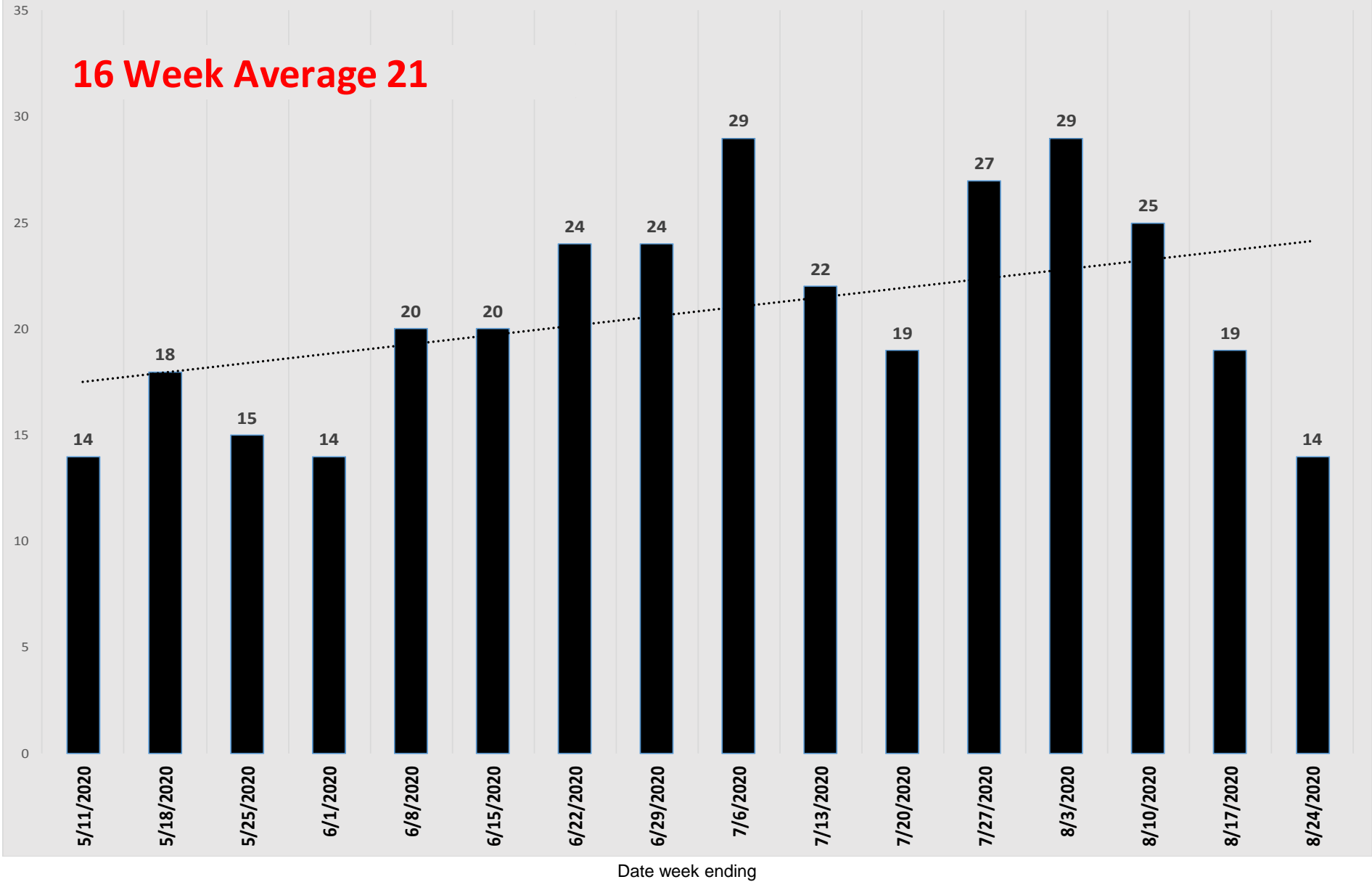

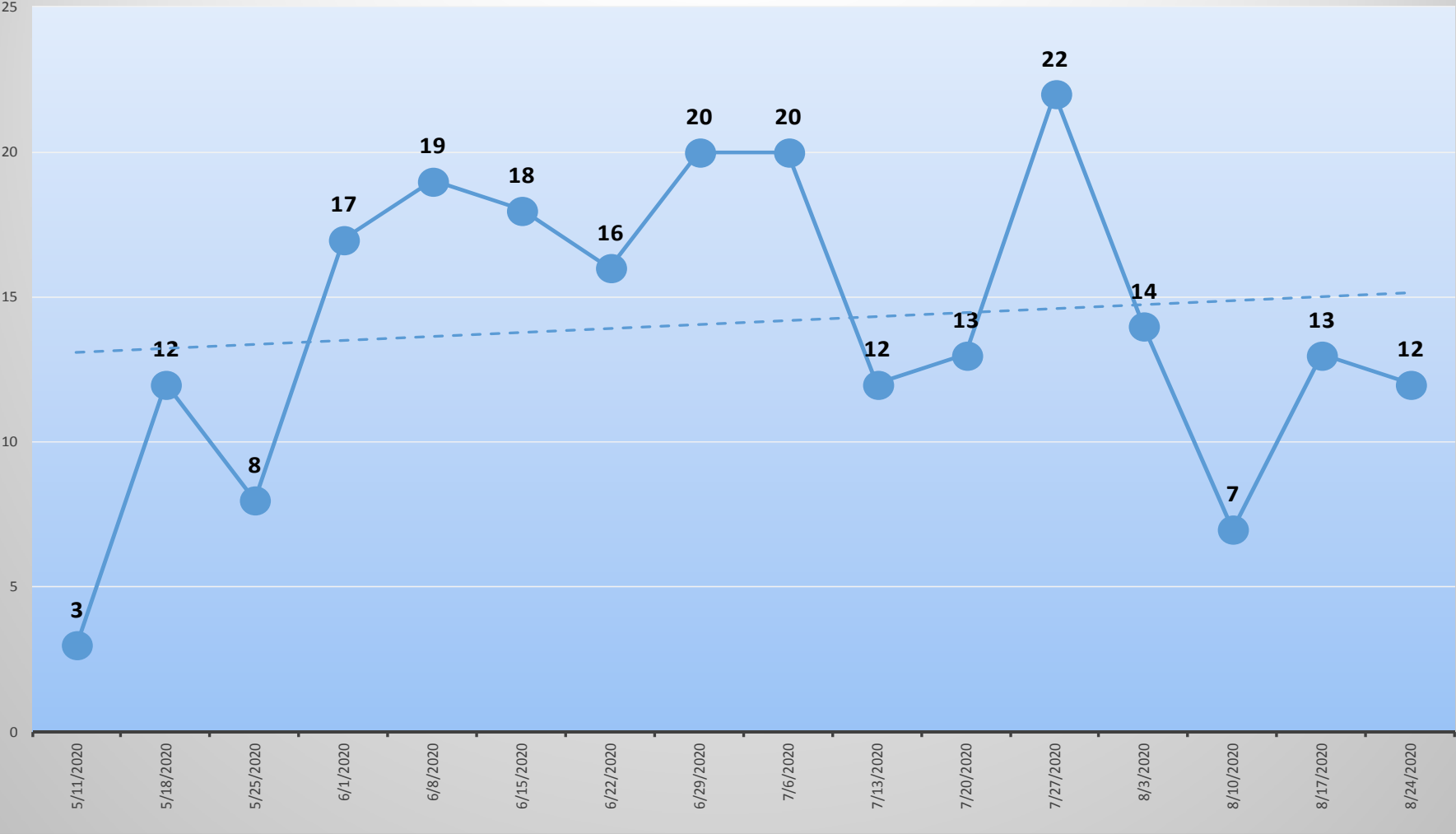

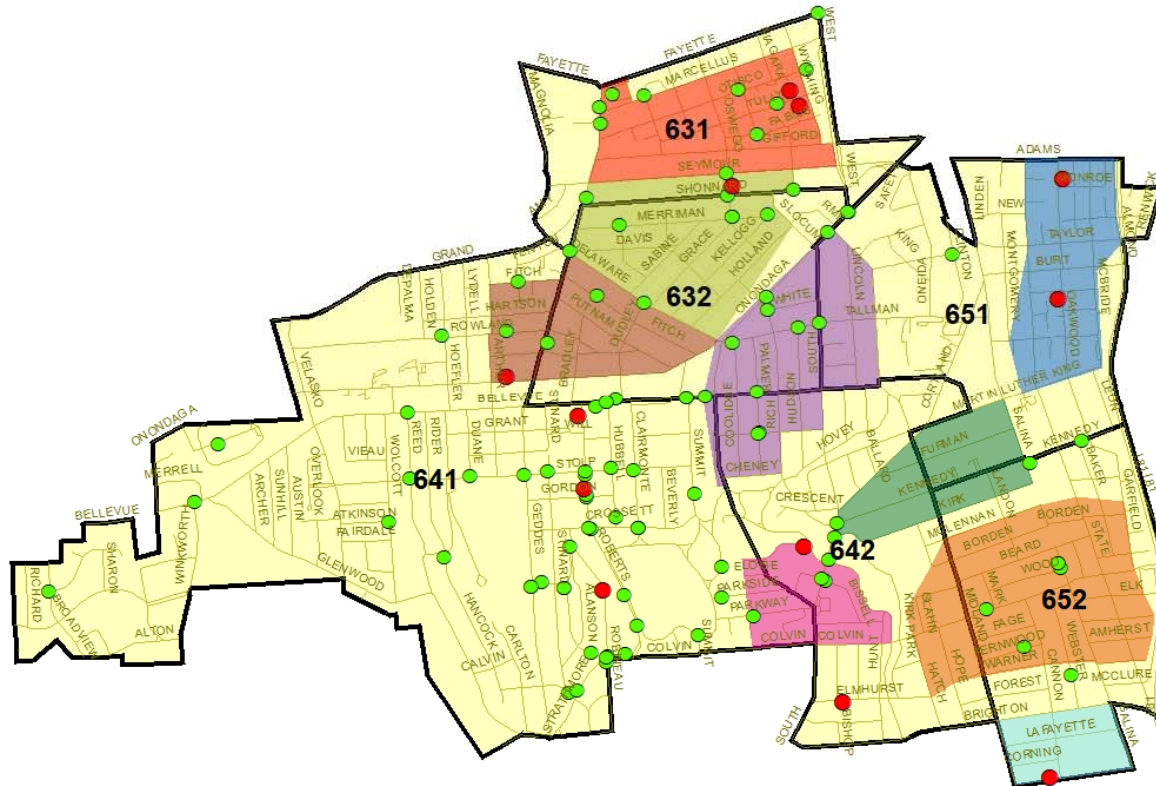
